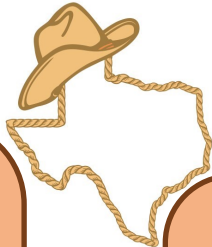

## swimming

There are 4 sessions available, Each 2 weeks long and for a total of 45 minutes per day.

Session 1: June 1st – June 12th      Session 3: June 29th – July 10th

Session 2: June 15th – June 26th      Session 4: July 13th – July
